II.		PRESIDENTS REPORT			
	A.	Return to Campus teams update	All teams submitted recommendations to Chancellor Neault in March 26. She will review the recommendations and then make her decisions about returning to campus. The team recommendations should be posted to the District intranet. The recommendations were broad in nature. During Denise’s regular meeting with the Chancellor, the Chancellor stated that the next few months will be like a long on-ramp to getting back to campus full-time, which is expected to be in spring 2022.		
	B.	Miscellaneous	Call for proposals for flex week will be sent out soon. Proposals do not have to be fully developed in order to submit. Tag team workshops are encouraged. Communities of Practice leads have upcoming workshops; an email will be sent out shortly with information on those workshops. April 13 is an equitable syllabus workshop facilitated by Dr Lasana Hotep; an email will be sent out shortly with information. This is the second of three workshops facilitated by Dr Hotep and the workshops are being recorded and will be made available for later viewing. 	1.	March Governing Board Curriculum Packet			

		Dee Aceves presented a summary of the curriculum packet that went to the Governing Board in March.
	2.	<p>SLOs and the Course Outline of Record</p> <p>Dee stated that the review of SLOs will now be integrated with the review of the COR rather than occur as separate processes as has been done in the past. If your COR is current but SLOs are not there will be a process for that.</p>
	3.	<p>Course Revision Policy</p> <p>At the start of the year there were approximately 600 CORs that were out of date. Regular reviews of outlines are ways to use curriculum as vehicles for equity. Dee provided an equity framework from Skyline College which looked at equity from three different process standpoints: traditional, transitional, and transformational. We at GC are moving from traditional to transitional. Dee informed us on ways the Curriculum Committee will provide support to faculty as they engage in the work of reviewing their outlines. Dee reminded us that CORs must be reviewed at least every 5 years by completing a course modification and submitting through the curriculum process. CORs not submitted for review every 5 years will be subject to deletion. There will be a two year grace period. Contact Dee with any questions.</p>
	4.	<p>ACCJC follow-up visit and PSLO assessment workshop</p> <p>Tate Hurvitz reminded us that the ACCJC follow up visit is later this week. Tate noted that some of us may be asked to participate in interviews and he asked us to do everything we can to participate. There is a new workshop coming up on April 30, "Assessment Planning for Courses & Programs," where a small group from each department can work together to draft an assessment plan that includes course and program assessments (PSLOs) into a cycle in draft form in three hours, along with feedback from facilitators to bring back to the department for discussion. The new assessment cycle starts in the fall. Tate noted that there is a new feature in Canvas where assignments can be tagged with SLOs so that when they are assessed it automatically is part of the SLO assessment that we collect for that assessment. Very easy way to do SLO assessment. Follow up with Felicia on how to use the feature.</p>
	5.	<p>Announcement of Senate Officer candidates</p> <p>Voting for Senate Officers will begin April 15 and run through April 29.
