Hope to implement training at the beginning of every academic year. Also working on Canvas Container to add information on Brown Act, Statewide Senate resources and info on Senate committees.

5	5.3	Board Policies – The District reviews a number of policies every 5-6 years. ExplainedBoard Policy and Administrative Policy. Developed based on Accreditation requirements,Title V, Department of Ed, etc. Explained that 10+1 as an example. Some are forwarded tothe AS for feedback. Pearl decides who should provide input and will forward tocommittee. Example is Academic Freedom policy. Forwarded to EDTCCC to view from

5.4	 Other College Governance review – During College Council, Dr. Gable shared survey results and a timeline of review process taking place this academic year. Dr. Gable was unable to attend this meeting but will return on 9/20/21 to share information and collect feedback. Web Advisor/Self-Service - Emails were received from faculty regarding issues with WebAdvisor/Self Service. Confusion and frustration with system. Both AS presidents met with Dr. Neault and shared concerns. Dr. Neault shared that she has hired a consultant to do an entire review of the registration process. Cindi Harris raised hand and requested opportunity to speak to consultant about personal experiences with system. Includes other faculty who have concerns. Pearl also shared that David Ogul has a website committee that will be reconvening to work on website. Vision & Mission Statements - Will invite Dr. Ahrens to come to a Senate meeting to present. Cuyamaca has completed their statements. District waiting to update theirs after Grossmont is finished. Brown Act – no final word on extension. Still in the process. No place on campus to meet in person safely with a 6-foot distance. Refugees – No news on where Afghanistan refugees will be going in the US. Reminder of how things were when refugees from Iraq came to San Diego and Grossmont. A lot of confusion on how to serve students. Hopes Grossmont and faculty will be better prepared to support and understand students. Reminder of Return to Campus webinar by Dr. Gable. May not be an opportunity for Chat. Recommend sending concerns to Graylin to make sure they are addressed. Question from faculty on how to support counseling faculty at webinar or otherwise. Pearl said she would consult with Maite to discuss how to support.
