6.1	<p>Participatory Governance - College Council</p> <p>Rewriting of Handbook and assistance and expertise from all participatory governance committees will be solicited and Dr. Gable will join us to in our next meeting to guide us further in this task.</p>
6.2	<p>Vision and Mission Statement – Feedback was received for possible vision and mission statements. Results were shared. President will summarize findings and submit to CPIE for consideration.</p>
6.3	<p>Reengagement Groups Meeting (CRPG) – Chancellor Neault presented a list of guiding principles for this planning group at the 9/30/21 forum on Budget and Return to Campus. Materials from the forum are forthcoming. Faculty and staff review and feedback on these materials is needed and appreciated. Senators engaged in discussion about possible feedback to the CRPG. Dr. Whisenhunt indicated that more modes of student feedback and communication are being initiated on the website and elsewhere.</p>
6.4	<p>Other - Chancellor Neault is working with a consultant to assess our student registration processes. Faculty will have the chance to offer input to the consultant who will work with the Chancellor and an intercollegiate committee. Senator Robin Sepulveda related that the interface between state enrollment portals and GC enrollment is faulty and requires immediate attention.</p> <p>Listing of Academic Affairs Council (AAC) members. The selection was difficult since there were so many excellent candidates. Composition will be reconsidered in one year.</p> <p>DE Coordinator, Dave Dillon, is taking a .2 reduction so there will be a call for this vacancy. OTLC is a Senate Committee, but overseen by LTRC Dean, Eric Klein. More discussion on structure and composition of the committee will occur. Dave commented and said one purpose of his decision is to familiarize others with OTLC committee work.</p>
