## California Code of Regulations, Section 53200(c)

"Academic and professional matters" means the following policy development and implementation matters:

(1) \*curriculum, including establishing prerequisites and placing courses within disciplines;

(2) \*degree and certificate requirements;

(3) \*grading policies;

(4) \*\*educational program development;

(5) \*standards or policies regarding student preparation and success;

(6) \*\*district and college governance structures, as related to faculty roles;

 (7) \*faculty roles and involvement in accreditation processes, including selfstudy and annual reports;

(8) \*policies for faculty professional development activities;

(9) \*\*processes for program review;

(10) \*\*processes for institutional planning and budget development; and

(11) \*\*other academic and professional matters as are mutually agreed upon between the governing board and the academic senate
