Online/Canvas Training

Which one is best for you?

Face-to-Face Only

This group of instructors typically need a minimal Canvas presence. You may want to upload your syllabus, create a home page, send announcements as needed and possibly use Canvas to collect and grade assignments.

We recommend one of the following options:

- Book appointment with Instructional Designer (ID). The ID will share resources and suggestions to fit your needs
- Enroll in the self-paced Introduction to Teaching with Canvas. Self-select portions you would like to study

Prepare for Emergencies

This group of instructors may prefer to teach in person, but would like to be prepared in the event of the need for remote instruction. You may want to use Canvas to house your instructional content, keep it up to date and refine it each semester so that you can transition as needed.

We recommend the first five modules of the self-paced or facilitated versions of the Introduction to Teaching with Canvas courses. – Registration Form

DE Certification

This path provides the most flexibility for future teaching assignments. Obtaining DE Certification allows instructors to accept face-to-face, hybrid, online synchronous and online asynchronous assignments.

Time permitting, we recommend the facilitated Introduction to Teaching with Canvas course. The facilitated course includes zoom sessions that allow for deeper conversation and support. You may also choose to complete the self-paced Introduction to Teaching with Canvas course along with the final project for DE Certification. – Registration Form
