About Campus-Based Scholarships

- We have scholarships each semester available to all students who are currently enrolled and planning on returning the following semester ranging from \$250-\$2,000 per semester
- This fall, we distributed over 300 scholarships and nearly \$200,000
- Students can apply through one simple online application that will match them with scholarships they qualify for on the backend
- Scholarships are facilitated through the Foundation for Grossmont & Cuyamaca Colleges, while working closely with Financial Aid







Why Scholarships are Important

"Receiving this scholarship motivates me to continue to do well in my classes as well as relieves stress trying to buy school materials like a new laptop."

Deadline to Register for Spring Classes: January 5, 2023

Scholarships Funded: End of January 2023

- 2. Complete the application students are encouraged to take their time and seek assistance. These scholarships are competitive, and applications will be reviewed by a committee
- 3. Submit application before October 28, 2022

How the Application Works

- Scholarships are competitive and all applications will be reviewed by 3 separate reviewers
- Scholarship applications are matched to scholarships by a variety of criteria, including:
 - Data imported through Colleague (GPA, Units completed/enrolled, etc.)
 - Major
 - Special Programs







What the Review Committee will be reviewing

- Essay question
- Career goals question

- All are scored on a 1-5 point system based on content, readability, flow, grammar and spelling
- Reviewers will also score based on if applicant adheres to instructions of questions, including word count minimum







What is the Review Committee looking for?

- Complete, thoughtful answers to essay questions
- Specific examples to help support statements
- All instructional prompts are followed
- Grammar and spelling
