- The Admissions & Records Office will validate a student's self-reported residency status.
- The Financial Aid Office will access enrollment reports for the purpose of determining student financial
 aid eligibility for combining units. You or your designee will also receive email notifications when a
 student adds or drops a course intended to be included for financial aid consideration.



Increases enrollment at the Teaching College




Overview of Exchange



Sample Student Use

On track to complete; enrolled in third semester at Home College Needs Oral Comm, but it's not available at Home College Finds Oral Comm via CVC Exchange; instantly enrolls Finishes course; credits transfer to Home College via eTranscript Completes program on time!



Home College

Grossmont students can utilize the Course Exchange to enroll at any CCC institution that is a Teaching College instantly

Grossmont is a Home College as of 1/31/23

Teaching College

- Grossmont is enrolled in the July 2024 Teaching College Implementation Cohort
- CCC students can enroll at Grossmont instantly starting Fall 2024
- Grossmont will get the FTES for students who enroll in Grossmont online courses through the Exchange

BENEFITS TO THE STUDENT

Student Feedback: Why did you use the Exchange?



"I wanted to take an ethnic studies course but the option at my local community college didn't articulate – I needed one that did." "I couldn't find the class I needed at my local college."

"I needed to pick up a physical science class to complete my transfer requirements." "I was in a situation where I had to drop a class I needed for my ADT. I was referred to the Exchange and was able to find an equivalent course. That meant I didn't have to stay in school for a whole additional semester!"

Benefits to the College

Home College

- Access to enrollment data for students who go outside of district
- Ability to create fully online pathways
- Ethnic studies, online STEM
- Completions

Teaching College

- FTES from students outside of your typical area
- Ability to run otherwise hard-to-fill courses
- Fewer canceled sections

CVC Exchange Summary	FY 2021-22	FY 2022-23
Home Colleges	73	90
Teaching Colleges	16	26 (8 in progress)
Cross-Enrollments	1,204	1,998
Students Directed to CCC Apply	10,830	16,515



Concerns:

- Potential Enrollment Loss between Spring '23 (Home College) and Fall '24 (Teaching College)
 - Marketing (or lack thereof)
 - Dashboard
- Transfer eligibility for our students planning on transfer to SDSU and utilizing the Course Exchange for many of SDSU's transfer majors that require 100% of a students' units coming from the local service area for priority transfer status
 - Communication
 - Counseling
 - Filter

Definitions

- Consortium: network of colleges who signed the Master Consortium Agreement
- **Exchange:** an innovative **tool** that allows students currently enrolled in a CCC to instantly enroll in online courses offered at eligible colleges without filling out a separate application

Who gets what?

When a student takes a course through the CVC Exchange . . .

- The home college gets the degree/certificate completion
- The teaching college gets FTES for course, as with any student
