"Cal-GetC"





- X ICAS created Cal GETC standards and approved the first edition "Cal-Getc Standards, version 1.0" on May 22nd
- X All courses included in the pattern must meet BOTH CSU and UC requirements
- X ICAS plans on working through the next set of revisions this Fall
- X There will be a focus on Areas 2-5 in the review which include: 2) Mathematical Concepts and Quantitative Reasoning, 3)
 Arts and Humanities, 4) Social and Behavioral Sciences, 5) Physical and Biological Sciences

UC will accept Oral Communication as a new (third) course in Area 1.

The number of courses required in Area 3 - Arts and Humanities is decreased from three to two (one in Arts, one in Humanities).

UC will remove its Language Other than English proficiency requirement from IGETC and treat it as a graduation requirement.

- Removal of competencies, instead courses will be required by area like transfer GE
- Residency changes from "College" to "District"
- Includes use of non-credit courses to satisfy requirements (e.g. CPL)
- Allows colleges to compute a min. 2.0 GPA by excluding courses not used to satisfy the degree requirements
- X Enables baccalaureate degree to clear local GE



Intermediate Alegbra





- x AB 1705 requires, as a result of our local data, that all courses below transfer be removed from the requisites
- x GC Math Faculty are working with departments to update requisites and either remove entirely or replace with level and placement



- x Articulation will not be compromised as long as the level is represented in the prerequisite for advanced courses (e.g. pre-calculus)
- x Articulation recommendation: Math level alongside "appropriate placement"
