7.1 Campus Update- Dr. Denise Whisenhunt

- The grill will be open from 10:30am-5:30pm Weekdays. The Java Market will be open from 8am-5:30pm Monday-Thursday & 8am-3pm Fridays.
- A power issue over the weekend caused all the food to spoil in the refrigeration at the Grill. Due to health & safety issues, no refrigerated foods can be served until the fridges regulate back in temperature.
- Portable heaters have been put in many spaces, due to the challenges with the heating system.
- Enrollment is on an upward trajectory. Dr. Whisenhunt acknowledged faculty for creating that environment of One College, One Team. There has been a reduction in financial aid applications. Encourage your students to apply for financial aid.
- Welcome to the spring semester. An acknowledgement & appreciation for all the faculty & staff and what they do for our students.

7.2 Compressed Calendar- Dr. Marshall Fulbright

• Dr. Fulbright presented an update on the Compressed Calendar and how it will impact the overall semester schedules for faculty and students. Shared information about block schedule changes. Question about courses that overlap and have time conflict so students cannot enroll. Dr. Fulbright shared that students are allowed to get exemption to enroll. Concern over inability to do this for chemistry due to a compressed calendar. Dr. Fulbright shared that chemistry will not be on block schedule and will need to decide how much overlap is acceptable. Another question about how to advertise to students on what to do if they have a time conflict situation. Most students go to counseling. Suggestion to add an alert on Self-Service. Dr. Fulbright will look into it. Question about length of time to transition to a compressed calendar. Dr. Fulbright's experience was 2.5 years. A minimum of a year to figure things out. Will have to fumble through and make ongoing changes. See full presentation in attachments.
