HyFlex Definition

- **What is a HyFlex class?**
 - A HyFlex course is taught on campus in a face-to-face classroom setting while also being broadcast live via Zoom so students can participate remotely
 - Students have the option to choose whether to attend each class session in-person or online via zoom
 - It is possible for faculty to require in-person attendance for a select few dates, but those exact dates must be included in the class schedule
 - To date, no instructors have utilized that option in HyFlex courses
 - This is probably for the best to minimize confusion regarding the HyFlex and Hybrid modalities

HyFlex Coding

- HyFlex has had some Coding issues
 - Originally coded as “Lecture” (Fall 2022)
 - This negatively impacted some International students and Veterans receiving benefits
 - Coded as “Internet 100%” and tied to a Face-to-Face section to give students options and protect students who needed to establish residency (Spring 2023-Spring 2024)
 - Has caused a lot of confusion, so starting next Fall, HyFlex courses will once again be coded as “Lecture” with HyFlex Icon in the class schedule



HyFlex History

- **HyFlex classes began in Fall 2022**
 - **Fall 2022 – 14 HyFlex classes**
 - **Spring 2023 – 25 HyFlex classes**
 - **Fall 2023 – 22 HyFlex classes**
 - **Spring 2024 – 30 HyFlex classes**
- **34 Faculty who are fully trained and currently teaching or taught previously**
- **25 additional faculty who have begun the training process**

HyFlex Assignment Scheduling

- Any instructor can be assigned a HyFlex section BEFORE they are trained
 - The training takes place the semester before their first assignment
- You must also be DE certified in order to teach a HyFlex course
- Instructors have to let their department chair know via email that they are interested in teaching a HyFlex section

HyFlex Enrollment

- **Fall 2023**
 - **84% fill-rate**
- **Spring 2024**
 - **73% fill-rate**

HyFlex Student Feedback

- 98% of student respondents said they appreciated the option to attend in-person or online
- On a scale from 1-5, students rated the importance of the flexibility of attendance modality in relation to their success in the class at 4.48
- 87% of students said their experience was either “excellent” or “good”
- 87% said they would definitely enroll in another HyFlex course
- 82% said they want to see more classes offered in the HyFlex modality

Spring 2023 Success Rates

- Online classes: 66
- **HyFlex classes: 71**
- On-campus classes: 73

Fall 2023 Success Rates

- Online classes: 67
- **HyFlex classes: 74**
- On-campus classes: 73

Fall 2022 Retention Rates

- Online classes: 84
- **HyFlex classes: 90**
- On-campus classes: 88

Spring 2023 Retention Rates

- Online classes: 82
- **HyFlex classes: 86**
- On-campus classes: 87
