

NextUp Foster Youth Services

Basic requirements are:

- Be a current or former foster youth who was in care on or after their 13th birthday.
- Provide proof of FY status with a dependency letter or CSAC WebGrants verification.
- Be under 26 years old at the start of the academic year (July 1st for Grossmont) OR qualify through AB 190.
- Work towards subsequent enrollment in at least 9 units.
- Apply for EOPS and the FAFSA application.
