## **CHAIR REPORT:**

- GE Subcommittee Recommendation: Dee shared that the GE Subcommittee is continuing its work on drafting a recommendation. There will be one more meeting to finalize the recommendation/s that will be shared to the committee. Items the subcommittee has covered include a policy review and pain points with the current format/structure. General themes shared is that the GE options need to be more flexible. Interest in aligning the GE structure/format with what Cuyamaca offers and how other community colleges in the state format their General Education (GE) options.
- Ethnic Studies Update: Title 5 changes will be voted on in July 2021 for the community colleges. Grossmont and Cuyamaca Colleges will work together to implement Ethnic Studies after the law passes. CSU Articulation is not finalized yet. Articulation Officers (AOs) and Ethnic Studies faculty have a state-wide meeting next week. Area F has a lot of denials so far.
- Curriculum Committee Charge/Mission & Composition: Draft was shared and approved at Academic Senate last week with a request for one small edit to revise the word "purpose" that was in the draft mission/charge twice. Updated by the committee during today's meeting. Revised draft attached.
