## APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

- ▷ Your username will be your firstname.last name (gizmo.griffin) and your password will be your six digit birthdate (MMDDYY)
- ▷ Go to "Orientation, Placement and Advising", and complete "Step 1 - Online Orientation"
- ▷ Next, complete "Step 2 - Placement Questionnaire", to determine your recommended placement level in Math and English, or ESL

Grossmont-Cuyamaca College Promise (if eligible) – No application or income requirements

- Up to 2 years free upon meeting eligibility requirements semester by semester
- Eligibility Requirements:
  - Be a CA resident or AB540 eligible
  - Complete FAFSA or CA Dream Act
  - Attend as a full-time student (12 units) at Grossmont or Cuyamaca (or 6 units if approved through the Accessibility Resource Center)
  - Maintain a 2.0 college grade point average or higher during your first year to remain eligible for your second
