Part-time Representatives, and when applicable, interim Representatives shall be selected by Part-Time faculty in a democratic manner. Seats will be up for election every Fall semester and the election will be conducted at each division or department meeting during flex week or

through an online voting tool that can be deployed within each division, department, or the ASPTFC. All part-time faculty will vote for their respective division and department representatives.

Senator seat vacancies that occur within a term may be filled on an interim basis by a current department representative from that division upon committee approval. The seat may also be filled after a call out and special election is conducted.

Notes

A simple majority of Senators including Senator designees recognized by the Chair at the opening of meetings shall constitute a quorum. Department Representative positions not filled by departments will not be included in quorum determination. Minutes to be sent to all Part-Time Faculty.
