4. Committees:	Budget-Bryan/Theresa/Dawn - report postponed College Council- Diana : The meeting got a bit heated. SDICCA indicated that the Equity plan recommendations needed revision before being moved forward. DLR was hired to do a space analysis and findings were that we are overly reliant on modular classrooms, need to look at room scheduling efficiencies, lack of student centered spaces and flexibility in scheduling offices. Strategic Hires - 2 Administrative positions and the Admin III position (A&r/Financial Aid) have been demoted without an Org Mod form being processed. Colleen shared why the Administrative Assistant position was changed from a III to II, due to the change in the manager level from an M-10 to an M-8. The assistant positions are tied to the manager level in the contract. Administrators Association will need to be the bargaining unit to fight this change should they choose to do so.  Facilities-Colleen (committee recorder) shared that this committee has not had Classified Representation in 3 months which is slowing down the process of prioritizing Facility requests. The committee is looking for ways to consolidate room use in order to reduce the burden on the custodial staff, reducing the number of rooms that need to be cleaned on a daily basis. There were 5 requests made in the current AUP process; Meditation/Prayer room in the 500 complex, Mental Health services expansion, Biology Cabinets and Chemistry Fume hoods. The Meditation room request has been tabled due to issues that need to be worked out (a.k.a one room will not be enough due to need for a male and a female prayer room)  SSE-Andrew/Janet - The committee will be revising it's proposal on the Equity Plan to make the language more College Council friendly. Staffing recommendations will be taken to the Staffing Committee. Niko Crumpton reported on Tutoring's Equity work, including Student Athlete Study sessions and the need to supply food to keep students on campus. SSE is working on setting up Focus groups for men of color in the fall in orde
