9. 9+1 addition to AB2510	Michele Martens gave a brief summary of Academic Senates 10+1, Students 9+1 that are already included in AP2510. 4CS has been working for years to get a 9+1 on the books for Classified Professionals. We have been working to get a draft proposal approved at both colleges to be included in AP2510 at the district. In February the Chancellor gave the green light, going so far as to suggest where it would go in the document. We began by Sunshining the 9+1 at the Cuyamaca Academic Senate and then at Grossmont's Academic Senate meeting. An email was received following the Cuyamaca presentation that the Chancellor had not given permission to move forward with this addition. We are getting delayed at every turn. Very frustrating.
