7. Articulation Report

- a. AB 928 (single lower division GE transfer pathway)
 - Fall 2025 we begin using the Cal-GETC pattern. GE units for Cal-GETC is 34
 - Students will have catalog rights to old GE patterns as long as they meet the requirement (consecutive enrollment, no break longer than 2 primary semesters)
- b. AB 1111 (Common Course Numbering)
 - Phase 1: 6 Courses
 - College Composition, Argumentative Writing and Critical Thinking, Public Speaking, Intro to Statistics, Intro to American Government and Politics, and Intro to Psychology.
 - Phase 2: 20 Courses
 - Phase 3: 50 Courses
