- **SLO Liaisons' Meetup** was a success with a vast majority attending (around 70%) and several follow-ups from both those not able to attend and those attending, indicating high interaction and interest. Discussion focused on Nuventive, integrated planning and also PSLO assessment.
- **Most Chairs have been working on the AUP** and focusing their questions on that right now. Most questions are technical in re: Nuventive, and/or process-oriented, rather than about SLOs per se.
- **Trainings, Workshops, Flex Week:** *all* the recordings, slides, etc. are available online via the Canvas Outcomes Assessment course.
 - Two *new* videos on using Nuventive are also available
 - Videos will be short and focused on particular tasks.
 - Next up: how to find your upcoming assessments report.
- **For PSLO Assessment**, Felicia is developing a video tutorial to support the workshop discussions. Felicia is also debugging the mapping function (to create a report of PSLO results) in Nuventive.
 - So far one department has submitted PSLO assessment results.
- **"SLO Labs" are ongoing** and folks are attending. First one was ESBS division, second one had about six attendees (Tate Hurvitz facilitating).
- **Nuventive implementation** is ongoing, current priorities include Deans' access, AUP submissions, SSO/SAO units (including their outcomes, timeline, and personnel) and the integration of Program Review Dashboard data via Power BI integration.

 - Forms are coming in!! This will be an interesting new process of tracking these via the Curriculum Committee/ Tech Review meetings. The first meeting of Tech Review is Oct. 5. Dee Aceves expects to generate a list of which departments have SLO changes this fall also via our new reporting! So exciting to have a list we can use to ensure all changes are made!
