Main Takeaways

- Clarify purpose, responsibilities, and goals of the committee
- Improve communication within committee and with constituency members
- Explain how the committee is supposed to function and move from discussion to action
- 70% agree/strongly agree with feeling comfortable contributing ideas
- 77% agree/strongly agree that their ideas were treated with respect, whether or not others agreed
- 75% of the responses indicated that professional development directed at their role would be beneficial
- Committee processes, interactions, and outcomes are sometimes or almost always
 - Collaborative 85%
 - Transparent 77%
 - Evidence-based 77%
 - Effective 46%
 - Efficient 77%
