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5. Review & Update of Norms	Committee members reviewed the existing norms and agreed to use the same norms for the 2022-2023 academic year.
6. Review of New Committee Purpose & Responsibilities	Committee members reviewed the revised SSEC Purpose, Responsibilities and membership which was recommended to the College Council last spring 2022.

OLD BUSINESS (35 minutes)	
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7. Review of Student Equity Plan Timeline (5 minutes)	Victoria shared the Student Equity Plan Timeline and spoke about our next steps. She and Janet will work with the constituency representatives to share the Student Equity Plan the Classified Senate, Academic Senate, Associated Students of Grossmont College and the Administrative Leadership Roundtable. The goal is to inform and receive feedback. Victoria will also present to Cabinet next week. Steve said he could share the plan with the Academic Senate officers before they it is presented to Academic Senate. It is due to the State on November 30 th .
8. Student Equity Plan Workgroup Share Out (5 minutes)	Janet shared that it was helpful to hear ideas from other members of the Student Equity Plan Workgroup. She learned about the need and value of data, and thought the Student College Hour would be helpful. Andrew spoke about the process of digesting the data, discussing what factors might cause gaps, and what could be done to close the gaps. Many of the ideas went into the SEP draft. Victoria shared the Student Equity Plan Summer Retreat Agenda for July and August , and detailed the process the workgroup followed to create the Student Equity Plan.
9. Review Draft of Equity Plan in breakout groups (20 minutes)	Victoria shared Grossmont College Student Equity Plan Draft 2022-2025 . The SSEC members broke into small groups and reviewed the document in order to provide feedback.
