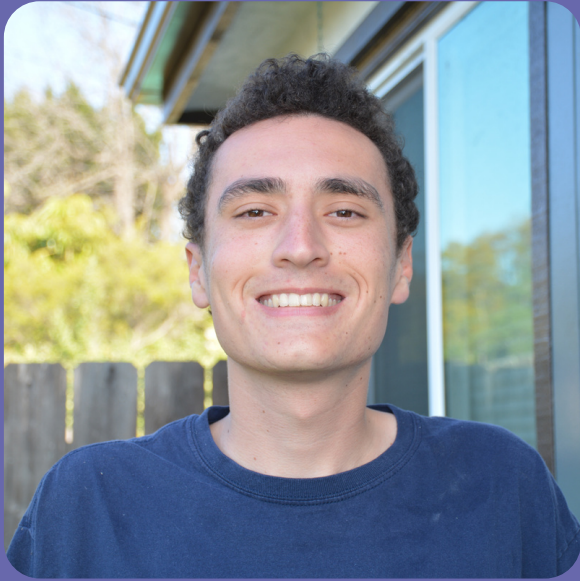
Emergency Grants for Students
