WHY APPLY?

- Free money to help cover tuition, books, supplies, and other educational related expenses
- Applicant pool only includes other Grossmont College students
- Application process is relatively easy and fast
- You can still apply and receive scholarships if you do not qualify for financial aid
- Some of our opportunities are automatically renewed as long as you maintain eligibility

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be currently enrolled at Grossmont College to apply
- Must be enrolled at Grossmont College during the upcoming Fall 2022 semester
- For most opportunities must have completed a minimum of 12 units (some opportunities require more units completed)

SCHOLARSHIP ESSAY & TIPS

Writing A Scholarship Essay:

Writing a compelling scholarship essay is not always easy. Below are some tips to help you write a great scholarship essay:

- **Read the directions**
 - Sometimes directions can clarify the intent of the question. If you don't follow the directions, you will give the scholarship committee a negative impression.
 - Think carefully about the question/s being asked and use this opportunity to tell the committee things about you that might not be shown elsewhere in the application.
- **Outline your essay: Brainstorm**
 - Writing an outline can help provide focus and structure to the essay. Too many application essays are written in a stream of consciousness style, which jumps from point to point and rambles without connecting one thought to another.
- **Be personal and specific:**
 - Share your story
 - Applications will often ask you to talk about yourself. As uncomfortable as this may feel, this is once in your life when it's necessary to brag. Tell them about recognition and awards you've received. Emphasize activities that show your talents and passions, especially things that demonstrate your ability to lead, take initiative, persist through adversity, and care for your community. Don't underestimate yourself - employment and family responsibilities can say a lot in your favor as well.
- **State clearly what your goals are**
 - Sponsors are looking to invest in your potential so they need to know your plans/your sense of purpose/objective/goals.
- **Allow yourself enough time:**
 - Spending the time writing about you will help solidify and strengthen your scholarship essay.
 - Give yourself enough time to edit and make corrections.
- **Edit, Edit, and Edit**
 - Look for grammar and spelling mistakes
 - You want your scholarship essay to flow smoothly
 - Have several strong writers read and proofread your essay for structure, grammar, redundancy and logic.

Last Minute Tips:

- **Carefully follow directions.**
 - If the application asks for a 200 word-essay, make sure to meet & not exceed word count
- **Proofread**
 - Triple check everything before you submit –look out for typos
 - Make sure you stay on topic when answering specific questions
 - Do not use slang
 - Do not leave any questions blank
- **Meet application deadline!**
